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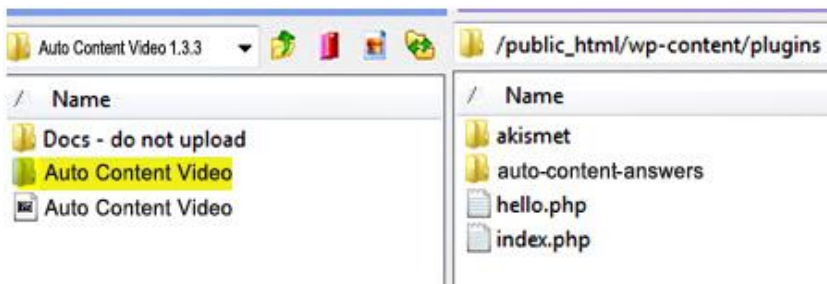
Auto Content Video

1) Installation

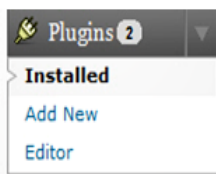
The install is very simple and if you have installed WordPress plug-ins before, this is no different.

Just to recap:

- Unzip the files to your computer's hard drive
- Upload them to the plug-in folder via your FTP client



- Upload the folder named “**Auto Content Video**” to the plug-ins folder. Once uploaded, log into your WP Admin area to activate it.



- Once the plug-in has been activated, click the **Tools** menu tab and then click the **Auto Content Video** link.



2) Configuration

- When the activation process of the plug-in is complete, you will need to configure the size of the videos within your blog post.



- Edit only the highlighted width and height. The rest of the coding should be left untouched.

3) Adding Search Terms (Keywords & Keyword Phrases)

There are several options available to you for adding your keywords and/keyword phrases:

Add Search Term

Search **1** Videos **2**
Categories - start with uppercase letter, keywords - start with lowercase letter.

Run every **3** 3 days humanize

Category **4** Uncategorized

Comments **5** yes

Post author **6** admin

Post status **7** Published

- 1) In this field you can choose one of three options: Videos, Category & Keyword* or Profile**. Selecting the “Video” option is best for finding the most relevant videos for your keyword and keyword phrase.
- 2) Enter only a single keyword or keyword phrase per search query.
- 3) Designate how frequently you wish to run your query per days or hours.
 - If you enter 3 in the text field and you select days, the plug-in will search your query and will give you results every 3 days.
 - If you activate the “humanize” option by clicking it, the plug-in will post results at random times which may vary between 1 to 60 minutes on the day or hour you selected.
 - If you activate the “skip initial posting” option by clicking it, the plug-in will generate the first results which are based on the run time. So, if you entered 3 days, the first result will be scheduled for posting in 3 days.
- 4) Choose in which blog category you prefer the video to be posted.
- 5) Select if you wish the plug-in to retrieve comments relevant to your search term.
- 6) Select the post author.
- 7) Select the post status
 - For automatic posting of the video used the “Published” option.
 - You may wish to review the videos first, in which case you will select “Pending Review,” “Draft” or “Private.”

*Selecting the “Category & Keyword” option for retrieving videos rather than the Video option in section 1) above will require adding the **category name** with the first letter in uppercase while the **keyword** or **keyword phrase** must be entered in lowercase.

Example: Category – Pets & Animals / Keyword: dog training
 The entry into the text box would be: Pet Animals dog training

Categories - start with uppercase letter, keywords - start with lowercase letter.

Note that the “&” had been dropped as it must not be included and the current available categories are:

**Selecting the “Profile” option would require that you actually have a profile into which you could post all your videos. You would simply select the Profile option and then you would enter your user name.

4) Search Options

The three search options which are available to you are: Top Rated, Most Viewed and Recently Features. Choosing anyone of these options would require that you use top level search term keywords or keyword phrases. For example: **Pet**.

Unfortunately, these three options do not give the most accurate results but they are available to those who wish to experiment with them. The good news is that the upcoming new version of this plug-in will all searching with empty search terms and so all videos in Top Rated, Most Viewed and Recently Featured will be retrieved.

5) Search Term Options

You may use the Boolean NOT (—) and/or the (|) operators to exclude videos or to find videos that are relevant to one of several search terms.

Retrieving more targeted videos and excluding certain keywords, can be accomplished in the following way:

- Exclude videos with (—) before a keyword:

- For an exact keyword or keyword phrase you would add it with quotation marks:

- To find videos which are relevant to one of several search terms you would add (|). So if you want videos matching **boating** or **sailing**, you would enter them as follows:

boating|sailing

Categories - start with uppercase letter, keywords - star

In much the same way, to find videos matching **boating** or **sailing** but not **fishing**, you would enter **boating|sailing+-fishing**.

6) Search Terms

The following is an overview after the keyword or keyword phrase has been set up.

- When the keyword or keyword phrase is initially added, you will a displayed message as follows:

A new video is being added right now. [Reload the page](#) to see the results.

- The plug-in uses a built-in WordPress function called “cron” and it runs your queries in the background. Please allow reasonable time for the plug-in to retrieve your first post as there may be, at times, as slight delay.
- The retrieve content will include some additional data:

- a) Displays how frequently content will be retrieved.
- b) Displays your blog's category.
- c) Displays when content was retrieve and posted last.
- d) Displays the number of the retrieved content.
- e) Displays the next time the plug-in is scheduled to retrieve and post content.

Note: Regardless of the setting, you have the option to **Pause** the process of any keyword or keyword phrase and also to activate it immediately by clicking on the **Run now** link.

7) Bad Comments Filter

You have the option of filtering out bad comments by marking them as spam. This method will prevent them from being added onto your blog automatically and without your approval.

- Enter the words or phrases (bad, dirty, curse, swear, offensive, etc. words) that you want filtered out into the default WordPress "Comments Blacklist."
